



* Please go inside for about 30 minutes when you see the truck spraying. Our drivers are instructed to cut off the sprayer if people are standing near the road.

* Please note that spraying may be cancelled or changed all or in part without notice.

* Please remember to check for standing water in your yards and dump water from all man-made containers. Toss, recycle, or store containers inside so that they can never hold water. Mosquitoes only need 1/8 inch of water to complete their life cycle.

New Hanover County Mosquito Spray Schedule 6/20/17 - 6/26/17

Surveillance shows that salt marsh and flood water mosquito populations are low. There are no scheduled spray sessions this week. Complaints will be handled on a case by case basis.
