



\* Please go inside for about 30 minutes when you see the truck spraying. Our drivers are instructed to cut off the sprayer if people are standing near the road.

\* Please note that spraying may be cancelled or changed all or in part without notice.

\*Please remember to check for standing water in your yards and dump water from all man-made containers. Toss, recycle, or store containers inside so that they can never hold water. Mosquitoes only need a teaspoon of water to complete their life cycle.
