

**NEW HANOVER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
DECLARATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY – SECOND AMENDMENT
ADDITIONAL PROHIBITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS**

Section 1: On March 20, 2020, pursuant to New Hanover County Code Chapter 17, Article III, Section 17.71 and Section 17.72, and North Carolina General Statutes Chapter 166A, Article 1A, 166A-19.22, the New Hanover County Board of Commissioners determined that a State of Emergency as defined in the New Hanover County Code Section 17.71 exists in New Hanover County, and now desires to further supplement said Declaration. The terms of this supplemental amendment are in addition to, not in lieu of, the March 20th and March 30th, 2020 Declarations.

Section 2: It is in the interest of all persons to slow the spread of the coronavirus and a unified response is optimal to do so. Pursuant to NCGS 166A-19.22(b)(2), the municipalities may hereby consent to and request that this state of emergency apply within their municipal corporate limits.

Section 3: The New Hanover County Board of Commissioners, acting through the Chair, hereby orders all county law enforcement officers, employees and all emergency management personnel to cooperate in the enforcement and implementation of the additional provisions of the county emergency ordinances, which are set forth below. This order and declaration is in addition to and concurrent with all public health control measures authorized in North Carolina General Statute 130A and the provisions of the March 20, 2020 Declaration of State of Emergency and March 30, 2020 Declaration of State of Emergency – First Amendment.

Section 4: Recreational boating. Recreational motorized boating is prohibited at the following:

- All local government owned and state owned public boat ramps;
- Privately owned boat ramps;
- Publically owned marinas; and
- Privately owned marinas

Excluded from this order are commercial fishing operations, boating use by governmental entities for public safety, and maritime fuel sales.

Section 5: This declaration shall become effective April 3, 2020 at 7:30 p.m. and remain in effect until 5:00 p.m. April 13, 2020 unless rescinded earlier or extended.
