New Hanover County Board of Health Mosquito Control Policy Statement

New Hanover County Health Department (NHCHD) provides mosquito control services to protect and promote the public's health as authorized by North Carolina General Statutes Chapter 130A-39. NHCHD uses Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) approved pesticides to achieve effective control of mosquitoes with the least impact on human health and the environment. NHCHD's preferred mosquito control strategy is the reduction of mosquito larva numbers through public education, source reduction, and the use of mosquito larvicides. However, the attractions of a coastal environment include characteristics and features that support the rapid development and succession of mosquito populations during much of the year. Therefore, methods to control adult mosquitoes are also required. The recognized practice and standard for adult mosquito control, by ultra low volume (ULV) application of pesticide, is conducted using truck-mounted equipment in residential areas for nuisance abatement and to protect the public's health from mosquito-borne disease.

Exclusion Procedure

NHCBH procedure addressing objection to adult mosquito nuisance control by truck-mounted ultra low volume (ULV) application of pesticide is as follows:

- An individual may have his/her owned or leased real property and a surrounding buffer up to 300 feet on all sides of the property excluded from ground based ULV adult mosquito nuisance control treatment.
- Each individual requesting exclusion must file a written submittal to NHCHD by completing a "*Adult Mosquito Nuisance Control Exclusion Form*", and must provide copies to the appropriate city, town or community association. All information denoted on the form must be supplied in order for the request to be processed by NHCHD. The completed form must provide a complete description of the property to be excluded and must be signed by the owner(s) or leasee(s).
- If the number of individual objectors, and/or the location of excluded properties preclude an effective mosquito control adulticide service for a community, the service in that community will be suspended. Adult mosquito control service may be reinstated to the community upon the written request of the local authority (city, town or community association), and further evaluation with favorable recommendation by NHCHD legal counsel.
- A city, town or community association may request NHCHD to rescind or modify a spray exclusion zone if they believe the exemption unfairly impacts other residents who desire adult mosquito nuisance control service. Appeals to rescind or modify spray exclusion requests must be made in writing and submitted for evaluation to NHCHD.
- NHCHD may periodically verify the continued occupancy/ownership by objectors of properties excluded from ULV ground spraying.
- In the event of mosquito-borne disease or conditions that threaten the public's health, the suspension of mosquito adulticide service in an area due to objectors will be discontinued and the full range of available mosquito control resources will be expediently launched.
